Authors are requested to adhere to the following guidelines for paper submission:

- a. Paper Details: Each paper must include the title, author's name(s), contact number, e-mail ID, and institutional affiliation with complete address (organization, city, state, and country).
- b. Length and Format: The paper should not exceed 3,000 words, be typed in Times New Roman, 12-point font, single-spaced, and submitted in Microsoft Word (.doc/.docx) format.
- c. Abstract and Keywords: An abstract not exceeding 150 words should be included, along with up to 10 keywords.
- d. Copyright Declaration: Each submission must be accompanied by a copyright declaration form as per the format available on the conference website.
- e. References: References should be prepared according to the APA Style Manual (<http://www.apastyle.org/>)
- f. Submission Email: Papers should be submitted via e-mail to the Organizing Secretary at: iskcom2026@gmail.com

- By Air** : Nearest Airports- Indore (200km), Nashik (200km), Aurangabad (200km), Jalgaon (110 km) and Mumbai (370 km).
- By Railway** : The nearest prominent railway stations on the main route are Chalisgaon(CSN), Jalgaon (JL), Bhusawal (BSL), 110 km, Manmad (MMR) (150 km) : Central Railway) and Amalner (AN) (50) KM, Nandurbar (NDB), 85 KM, Sindkheda(SNK), 20km, Nardana(NDN) 15km, (Western Railway via Surat, Ahmadabad route). Mumbai-Dhule(DHI).
- By Road** : Shirpur is 50 km away from Dhule and 200 km from Indore (MP), Surat (Gujarat), Nasik and Aurangabad. Buses are also available from Jalgaon (110km) and Bhusawal for Shirpur. Buses run between Dhule and Shirpur. Well connected by road through Mumbai-Agra National Highway (NH-3).
